The book of Ephesians, chapter 6, describes the armor that the Christian should put on by faith. Use your Bible to look up and name what the Richardsons needed to do to be strong in the Lord, and what all Christians need to do.



Eph. 6:14-17 says they needed to . . .

1. Remember they were protected by the righteousness of Jesus Christ.
2. Believe that they moved forward with the gospel of Peace.
3. Trust in the Living Word of Jesus Christ as their best Weapon, in the power of the Spirit.
4. Keep themselves for the Truth, Jesus Christ.
5. Trust in the great salvation of Jesus.
6. Protect themselves from the attacks of the enemy, through faith in Christ.

1. Have on the breastplate of
righteousness.
2. Have their feet shod with the
preparation of the gospel of Peace
3. Have the Sword of the Spirit, which
is the Word of God
4. Have their loins girded about with
truth
5. Wear the helmet of salvation

6. Hold the shield of faith to quench the
fiery darts of the wicked
